We acknowledge receipt of your request for public records, dated July 23, 2018, under the Right-to-Know Law (RTKL), 65 P.S. 67.101 et. seq.

Your request was forwarded to the Building Standards & Safety Department for a response.


You will see enclosed copies of records, consisting of two (2) pages.

We were advised by Judy Richards, Office Manager of the Building Standards & Safety Department, that no licenses were revoked in 2015 and 2016. In 2017, three hundred and eighteen (318) licenses were revoked. From 2015 through 2017, thirteen (13) illegal rental units were discovered.

By this letter, the City considers its obligation to honor your request under the RTKL to be fulfilled.
